

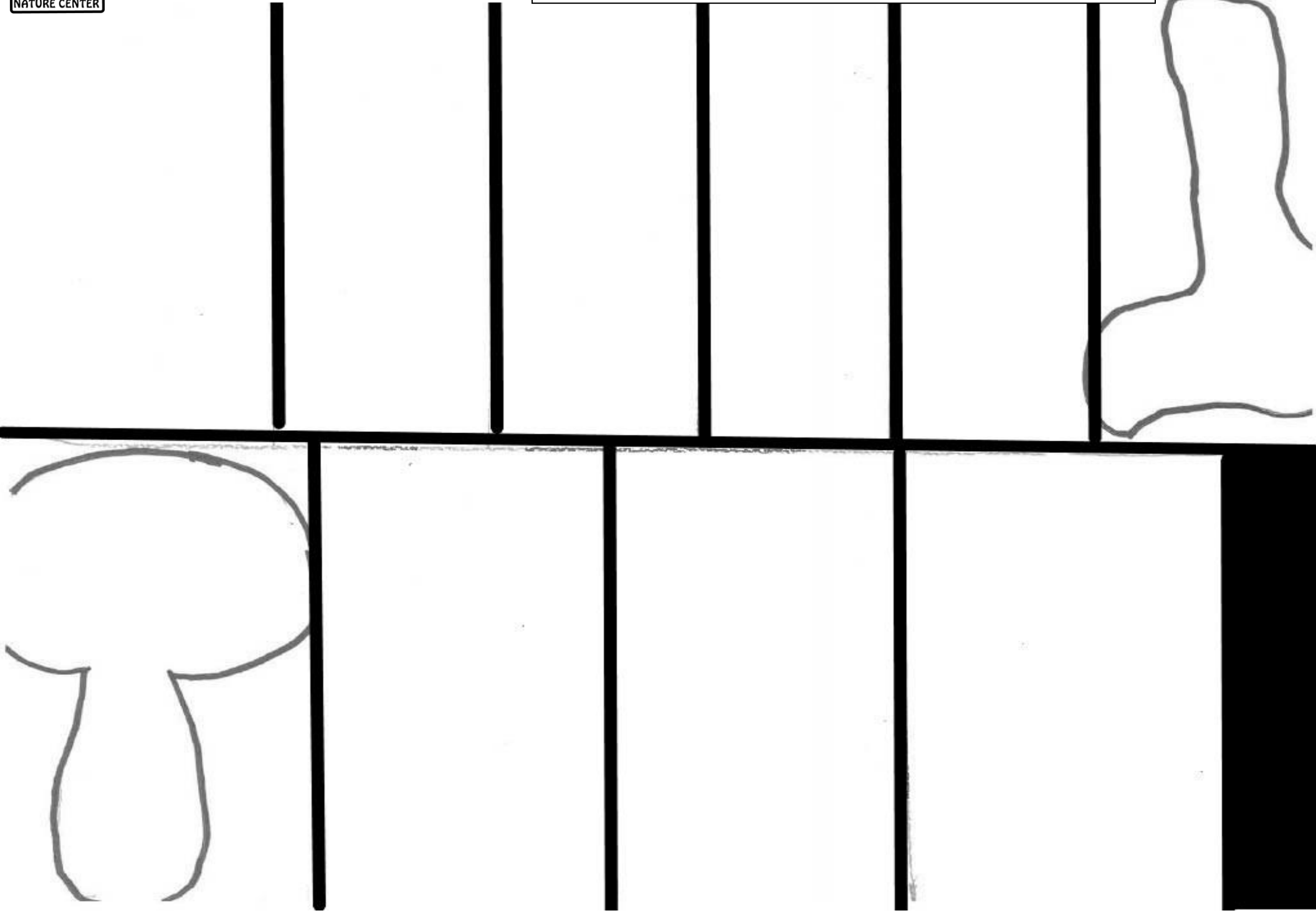


Mushroom Paper Chain Garland

CUT the horizontal line

FOLD the vertical lines like an accordion

The upside-down mushroom is the shape of a mushroom in the Russula genus. They shatter when thrown at trees! The bottom mushroom is in the genus Boletus. Boletes have "sponges" under their caps instead of gills.



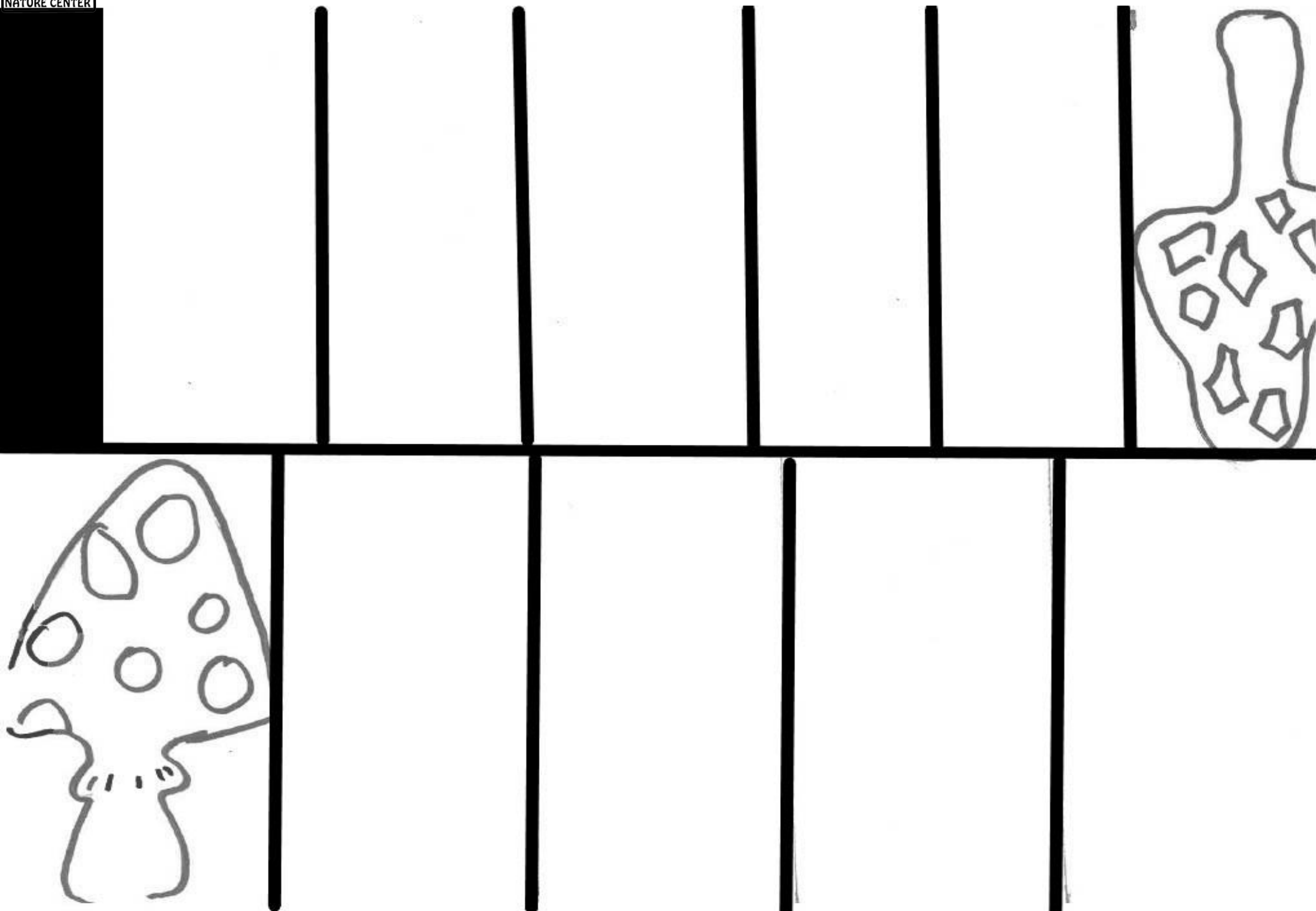


Mushroom Paper Chain Garland

The upside-down mushroom is called a morel, they are in the genus Morchella.
The bottom mushroom is in the genus Amanita. Amanitas are usually red, have white spots, and a veil.
